This term we are having a focus on phonics. We will be continuing our daily phonics sessions, including guided reading, as well as additional phonics practice in our English lessons.

We will be retelling and sequencing traditional tales with repeated phrases. Additionally, we will be focussing on our writing skills using adjectives, connectives and adverbs of time.

Maths

The children will be learning about money and the different coins, as well as practising ways to make different amounts of money using the coins.

We are beginning to look at multiplication and practising our 2, 5 and 10 times tables using arrays.

We will also be learning about analogue clocks and how to tell the time to the o'clock and half-hour.

PE

In PE Mrs Charles from Queens School is teaching us multi skills games. We will be using a variety of different equipment to learn the skills of throwing, catching, carrying, balancing, and different ways of moving. We will also be continuing our Relax Kids sessions on Mondays. These sessions help us to learn skills and encourage us to remain calm and focussed.

Art

As part of our topic Rumble in the Jungle, we will be studying the art of Henri Rousseau. We will be linking his paintings on tigers with our trip to Whipsnade Zoo.

The children will be using paint and the technique of small strokes to produce artwork based on his style.

Topic

Our first topic, Rumble in the Jungle, will focus on animals, what they eat, their habitats, and body structure. We will be visiting Whipsnade Zoo and observing the animals.

In our final topic Oh, We Do Like To Be Beside the Seaside, we will be looking at the key features of a seaside town. We will be looking at aerial photographs and maps.
