<b>Action</b>	<b>Cost</b>	<b>Outcome and Impact</b>
Purchase sports equipment	£600	Play equipment has been purchased to support MSA's in delivering games and activities at lunchtime. Children are now more active at lunchtimes participating in a range of physical activities. This also encouraged children to play cooperatively and develop their skills in team sports.
Sports coaching	3000	Lunchtime activities provided and sporting workshops for KS1 children for example Tennis during Wimbledon week.
School Sports Partnership	5000	Dedicated PE specialist, supported teachers 1 day a week in the delivery of lessons, this has involved team teaching and reflections on practice. The impact of the School Sport Partnership has resulted in teachers developing their skills in teaching a variety of games and activities. Staff training in the use of apparatus has developed confidence in supporting children to improve their skills in the use of apparatus. PE Subject Leader has had the opportunity to network with other schools and share good practice. MSA have received training in the delivery of games and activities which can be offered at lunchtime. Children have had the opportunity to participate in gymnastics and dance competitions.
