ICT

We will use Scratch (ICT program) to learn to use commands reasoning and problem solving to make simple animations linked to our topic.



Handwriting

We will continue to practise handwriting using lead in strokes. This will include writing high frequency words, practising sitting their writing on the line, using finger spaces and forming their letters correctly. Please also practise the alien and real words.

Topic

The children will focus on learning about Animals and plants that live under the sea. This will include learning new vocabulary, describing, identifying and labelling the features of common sea animals and plants. We will use maps and atlases to identify oceans /seas around the world, comparing tropical water to British water. We will also explore the properties of different materials while investigating sinking and floating.

Maths

We will be focusing on multiplication and division, using these skills to solve simple problems.

We will also be learning about time and fractions.
