WHAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING IN SCHOOL THIS WEEK

Nursery

This week we have been reading Rosie's Walk, we have been using and following positional language in, on, under, next to, behind. We have also been responding to who and where questions when talking and sharing books together. In our Role Play are we have added a pretend hot chocolate café.



Reception

This week we labelled objects from the 'Whatever next' story. We looked at pictures of outer space and looked at the important role that astronauts played in discovering our planets. Eq. Mae C. Jemison

In Maths we practiced comparing objects that are the same and some that are different. We looked at longer, shorter and taller.



Year 1

In English, we have innovated our class text from Stick Man to Stick Lady. In maths, we have been continuing to apply our knowledge of equal to calculations. In Geography we discussed keys on maps and added them to a map. On Thursday we were very lucky and had a visit from an artist which we enjoyed! We have been very busy rehearsing for our Christmas play.



Year 2

In English we have been learning about different suffixes and the rules for when we use them. In Maths we have been practising rebalancing and 'Think 10' as strategies for adding and subtracting. In Geography we learnt about the weather of Asia and used the Chromebooks to research weather patterns here. In Science we learnt about the importance of exercise and how it affects our bodies.

Nurserv

Next week we will be reading the story Where's Spot and will continue to practise the prepositional words when we are playing. In Maths we will be looking and comparing two groups of objects using the following words to help us. more less fewer

Reception Next week we will be reading the book Owl babies. This also continues to follow our learning about night time, dark/light, autumn and the outdoors.

> In Maths we will be practising creating patterns, looking at similar and different and how these can be represented in other ways e.g. a tens frame. We will also create a repeated pattern with a unit of repeat. In Science we will be looking at the different parts of owls and it's life cycle and what it means to be nocturnal.

English- We will be writing a story Year 1

Maths- Looking at bonds to 10

Topic- We will be going on a walk around Oxhey Park

English- We are going to be writing our class innovated versions of 'The Flower'. Year 2 Maths- We are learning about different strategies we could use for subtraction. Topic- We will be evaluating salad packaging in DT and deciding what makes effective eye catching packaging. We will be learning about the importance of exercise in Science and what happens to our bodies when we exercise.

HOMEWORK CHALLENGES

Please spend time with your child to explore this week's challenge. The teachers will talk to the children about what they have learnt at home every Friday.

Nursery:

Using a favourite soft toy, follow the adult's instructions where to put it. "Put teddy under the chair. Put teddy on the table. Put teddy next to/behind the plant". You could even try to play a twist on the game 'I Spy' but instead of guessing the word beginning with a certain letter, give clues as to the object's position, e.g. "I spy with my little eye, something behind the curtain" or "I spy with my little eye, something next to the plant".

Reception:

Have a look around your house, can you find two objects. Tell your adult which object is heavier and which one is lighter. Can you try to find a very heavy but smaller object and a large light object?

Year 1:

Continue to practise play lines

Year 2:

Can you draw a story map for your favourite story? Think about what happens during the opening, build up, problem, resolution and ending.
