WHAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING IN SCHOOL THIS WEEK

Nursery

This week we have been reading Rosie's Walk, we have been using and following positional language in, on, under, next to, behind. We have also been responding to who and where questions when talking and sharing books together.



Reception

This week we have read the story Owl Babies and the children have had fun learning facts about owls. The children have worked very hard at using their phonics knowledge to label the parts of an owl and learned what it means to be nocturnal.

In Maths we have introduced the language of thick and thin and compared different objects.



Year 1

We have been busy writing some fantastic stories in English using lots of adjectives. In Maths we have been learning about ten and some more. We have been busy practising the Christmas play and started decorating the classroom ready for Christmas magic.



Year 2

In English we innovated our class story of 'The Flower'. We changed the main character, the setting and the mystery object! In Maths we have been working hard on applying 'Think 10' to subtraction calculations. In D&T we have been looking at existing salad packaging and deciding if we like it/dislike it and what ideas we can magpie for our own salad packing designs. In History we learnt about the difficulties that Mary Séacole faced in her nursing career.



WHAT WE WILL BE DOING IN SCHOOL NEXT WEEK

Nursery

In maths we will be comparing different amounts within two groups by saying which has more, fewer, less. We will be practising drawing pictures of ourselves and include basic features.

Reception Next week we will be learning about the Nativity story and how we celebrate Christmas. We will also be writing letters to Santa. We will be practising our Christmas Nativity play and singing lots of Christmas songs.

> We will also be continuing to look at the key vocabulary for comparing mass and weight by introducing light and heavy.

Year 1

English- We will be using adverbs of time in a story

Maths - Understanding that ten and some more are the 'teen' numbers e.g. 13,

Topic- In science we will be carrying out an investigation into materials that are transparent and opaque

Year 2

English-We are going to be planning and writing our own independent versions of 'The Flower'.

Maths- We will be consolidating some of our learning from this term. Topic- In Science, we will be thinking about the importance of eating the right amounts foods from each of the different food groups. In PSHE we will be thinking about what makes a good friend.
