WHAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING IN SCHOOL THIS WEEK


Nursery

Year 1

This week we started our new unit in English; instructional writing. In maths, we have been revisiting prior learning. In Science, we have conducted an investigation and explored whether materials were transparent or opaque. On Friday we performed our Christmas play to the rest of the school.



Reception

This week we have been learning about patterns. We weighed Christmas resources on the balance scales and compared weights.

We looked at the artist Van Gogh and his work 'Starry Night' and we explored shades of blues to make swirly skies.



Year 2

This week we met our Year 2 visitor, Elvis the Elf. He has been making mischief and playing pranks on all of us! In English we have been learning about recount texts and unpicking their features.
