WHAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING IN SCHOOL THIS WEEK

Nursery

This week we have been retelling The Brown Bear story. In Maths over the past few weeks we have been sorting objects that are the same colour, type, shape and size. We have also been counting to 5 and have been using our fingers to show these numbers. Eg: Can you show three fingers?



Year 1

In English we have innovated our own version of the text Handa's Surprise - the stories have been a joy to read. In Maths, we have been looking at the language of addition. In Science we have been exploring the senses, touch and hearing. On Thursday we spoke about the importance of looking after our minds and we looked at mindfulness activities.





We learnt the phonics sounds f I e h. We had a visit from Goldilocks and drew pictures of Goldilocks and the cottage with the 3 bears. In maths we continued subitising, beginning to notice when values are fewer, more or the same as each other.



Year 2

This week in DT we took part in food tasting ready for designing our salads. We were brave and tried lots of new foods. In English we learnt how to edit our writing using purple polishing pens. In Maths we learnt how to represent, order and compare numbers using different representations.



WHAT WE WILL BE DOING IN SCHOOL NEXT WEEK

- **Nursery** We will be focusing on the maths concepts bigger and smaller when comparing objects in our play and environment. We will be reading the book Just Like Jasper by Mick Inkpen, in the story Jasper bought a new toy with his birthday money. We will identify the different toys within the story and talk about special toys to us. In our imaginative play we will be creating birthday celebrations....this could involve making cards for friends, drawing a food list for the party, making playdough cakes and decorations and singing happy birthday.
- **Reception** We will be learning the phonics sounds r j v y and w. Next week, we will be Introducing The Little Red Hen story and will be labelling characters, sequencing the story and even writing the story map In Maths we will be identifying more or less when subitising.

Year 1 English- We are going to be exploring poetry

Maths- We are going to be looking at problem solving

Topic- We are going to explore what Watford use to look like

Year 2 English- We will be starting our poetry appreciation week. We will be learning about weather poems.
Maths- We are learning new mental addition and subtraction strategies.
Topic- In Science we will be learning about a humans basic needs for survival. In Art we are developing printing techniques using foam squares.

HOMEWORK **CHALLENGES**

Please spend time with your child to explore this week's challenge. The teachers will talk to the children about what they have learnt at home every Friday.

Nurserv:

Encourage children to help match socks when putting the washing away. Why are they a match? What is the same/not the same about the socks? **Or** Using a collection of fruits and vegetables. (Have multiple pieces of the same type of fruit and vegetable). Mix up the items and ask children to match the different fruits and vegetables.

Reception:

Can you go on an Autumn walk and look for signs of Autumn. See if you can find any conkers or pinecones and create a collage with them. As a challenge you could draw an Autumn picture and try to label it using the sounds you have learnt in phonics.

Year 1:

In maths we have been looking at part whole models- can you put these number sentences into part whole models?

> 4 + 6 = 102 + 8 = 107 + 3 = 10

Year 2:

Can you write a list using commas? You could write a shopping list, a list of objects that you can find in your home or a list of things you can see while going on a walk. Remember, use 'and' between the last 2 items in your list!
