## WHAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING IN SCHOOL THIS WEEK

## Nursery

This week we have enjoyed sharing experiences and have been talking about Bonfire night and fireworks. We have used chalks and paints to recreate their own fireworks pictures. In Maths we have been using the words higher, taller and shorter to compare heights of different objects.



#### Year 1

It has been lovely welcoming the children back to school and hearing about their half-term adventures. In English, we were introduced to our new text Stick Man. In maths, we have been looking to find the difference. In history, we discussed the history of Watford Football Club. We discussed Remembrance Day and created poppies to bring to the Remembrance assembly on Monday. On Friday we celebrated Diwali in school.



## Reception

This week we read 'Whatever next 'and acted out the story of the bear going into Outer space in a rocket. We then drew pictures about it and recorded our own version.

Maths we have been practicing counting objects that are the same and some that are different.

We have also been making firework pictures.



#### Year 2

It has been lovely to welcome the children back after half term! This week in English we have been learning our new text 'The Flower' by John Light. In Maths we have been practising linking our number bonds to 10 to new calculations. In Geography we learnt about the weather in the Americas (North and South America) and compared this to weather we have in the UK. We designed our salads in DT ready for when we make them.

**Reception** Next week we will continue to look at 'Whatever next' and we will practise counting moving objects and starting our counting from a different place. We will also practice counting sounds.

Year 1 English- We will be using drama to retell the story

Maths- We will be looking at number equality and balance

Topic- In Science, we will be discussing the properties of materials

**Year 2** English- We will be learning about the suffixes 'ly' and 'er' and the rules when using them. We will also be learning about setting description.

Maths- We will be learning about near doubles and how they can help us with addition and subtraction.

Topic- We will be learning about the life events of Mary Seacole in History and how she helped to change nursing. In Science we will be learning about good hygiene. In Art we will be creating our final prints using foam squares and paint.
