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# WHAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING IN SCHOOL THIS WEEK

#### Nursery

We have enjoyed meeting and welcoming our new children into our Nursey this week. We are looking forward to getting to know them and their families over the coming year. We have settled back into nursery with a winter time focus talking about the cold weather, snow, snowmen. We have made and observed ice melting.



Year 1

In English we have been introduced to the traditional tale of 'The Three Little Pigs' and learning the story with actions. In Maths we have been looking at the value of numbers between 0-20 and started to order them based on their place value. In PSHE we talked about how we can all be incredible with New Year's resolutions and discussed our class rules again. In Geography we looked at the countries of the United Kingdom and the seas surrounding them. In Science we looked at the season of winter and compared it to autumn. In R.E we looked at how we all belong to different types of families.

#### Reception

This week we have introduced the topic 'Frozen Land', using our talking tub to find out what children already know about the topic. In maths, we have begun sorting objects and also thinking about different sorting criteria. In Literacy we are focusing on The Gingerbread Man story.



Year 2

It has been lovely welcoming the children back to school this week and hearing about all their adventures. This week in maths we have been focussing on part whole models. In English, we were introduced to our new text 'Jack and the Beanstalk'. We were introduced to our new topic in History this week 'The Great Fire of London'.



#### WHAT WE WILL BE DOING IN SCHOOL NEXT WEEK

- **Nursery** Next week we will be starting our new topic called 'Once Upon a time...' we will be reading lots of traditional stories our focus story is called **Goldilocks and the Three Bears.** In maths over the next few weeks we will be learning about patterns.
- **Reception** Next week, we are continuing to explore our story, thinking about our story map and also baking our own gingerbread biscuits. In maths, we will be continuing to sort in various categories.
- **Year 1** In English, we will be getting to know our text of 'The Three Little Pigs' through drama, answering questions and starting to use a question mark to ask questions in writing. In Maths, we will be looking at doubling and halving numbers to 20. In Geography we will be looking at the Physical Features of London; the hills and Identifying the River Thames. In PSHE, we will be looking at how we can all be successful and be proud of something.
- **Year 2** Maths: We are going to focus on money English: We are going to be exploring our new text 'Jack and the Beanstalk' Topic: We are going to be introduced to our new Geography topic.

# Please spend time with your child to explore this week's challenge. The teachers will talk to the children about what they have learnt at home every Friday.

#### Nursery:

Talk about the clothes you are wearing to keep you warm and dry in winter. Practise doing up your zips on your coats. Perhaps you could go on a wintery walk with a grown-up and look around to see the things that have changed, such as frost on the ground, no leaves on some trees, few flowers growing.

#### **Reception:**

We have been talking about different things that children find tricky sometimes and how they have to keep practising and never give up. Could you please talk to your grown-ups so they can share their experience in things that they have done and at which they persevered even when it appears difficult.

#### Year 1:

Please ask your child to tell you the story of `The Three Little Pigs'. Why not get them to draw you a text map or act out the story? You could record a video and email it in!

#### Year 2:

Can you do some research on our musical instrument the recorder, what melodies have you been learning in class ?
