your children into school with cash.

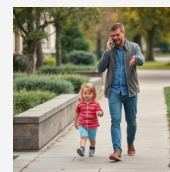
Father's Day is coming up! We are selling

WHAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING IN SCHOOL THIS WEEK

<p style="text-align: center;">Nursery</p> <p>This week in nursery, we have been learning about <i>People Who Help Us</i>, focusing on important roles such as doctors, nurses, and paramedics. The children have learnt about how these people help to keep us healthy. We have talked about how we keep ourselves healthy.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Reception</p> <p>This week we looked a little more at farms and our farmer duck story, in preparation for our visit to Aldenham Country Park and farm on the Friday. We wrote sentences and captions about the story. In Maths we looked at doubles and halves. We also sang Old Macdonald had a farm.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Year 1</p> <p>This week, in English we have been learning our new text of 'Peter Rabbit'. Also we are extremely proud of all of the children for completing their Phonics Screening. In Maths we were learning about fractions (half and quarters) of amounts. In PSHE we showed such pride in showing our baby photographs and compared them to the way we are now, thinking about the differences and similarities.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Year 2</p> <p>Year 2 have had another busy and exciting week! In English, we have been unpicking non-chronological reports and exploring their key features. In Maths, we have been applying our knowledge of number to solve a range of word problems. On Tuesday, we became food critics, tasting and evaluating different fruits and vegetables to help us decide what to include in our salads. On Thursday, we were very fortunate to welcome a member of our local community, who shared their family's story of the Windrush generation, helping us learn more about this important part of history. We have also been very busy rehearsing for our end of year play!</p>

WHAT WE WILL BE DOING IN SCHOOL NEXT WEEK

- Nursery** Next week, we will be learning about the important role of the dentist and how they help to keep our teeth healthy. On Thursday, we are excited to welcome some farm animals to visit us at Nursery. This will be a hands-on experience where the children will have the opportunity to touch, observe, and learn more about the animals. On Friday, we will be celebrating our **Sports Day**, and we would love for you to come along and cheer the children on as they take part in a range of fun activities!
- Reception** Next week we will continue looking at farms. We will especially look at ducks and the life cycle of ducks. In Maths we will look at odds and evens. We will be looking at patterns of animals and recreating some animals with art materials, using different materials with different textures.
- Year 1** In English, we will be answering questions about the text and thinking of questions to ask Peter Rabbit. In Maths we will be looking at fractions (half and quarter) of shapes. As part of our History topic of Titanic, we will be having our Titanic Day (Tuesday) and encourage the children to dress up! We are looking forward to Sports Day (Wednesday) too!
- Year 2** **English-** We will be focussing on reading comprehension.
Maths- We are going to be revisiting prior learning.
Topic- In Science, we are going to be making bug hotels. On Wednesday we are going to be taking part in Sports Day!
