- You must leave details of your child's name, class and the reason for absence - please don't just say 'feeling unwell' or 'under the weather'.

Guidance on illness

 If your child has vomiting or diarrhoea, they must be off for 48 hours from the last time they were sick or had a loose bowel movement.

WHAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING IN SCHOOL THIS WEEK

Nursery

This week we have started to read the story Jack and the Beanstalk recalling and are characters and key events. In phonics we playing and practising oral blending



games. The adult says the word in sounds m-a-t and the children blend the sounds together and say the word mat.

Reception

This week we have looked at planting, how to care for our plants and the equipment that we

need. We have practised these skills and planted our sunflowers. In Maths we really focused on number bonds to 5 and tried to recall all number bonds to 5.



Year 1


In English, we started to innovate the story of 'Tom and the Island of Dinosaurs', changing the characters to ourselves. In Maths, we learnt how arrays can be used to show repeated addition and multiplication. In Science, we identified the features of reptiles and had a small reptile visitor! In

Year 2

This week in Year 2 we have been very busy! We have been learning about 2D and 3D shapes and their properties. We have been usina language such as vertices, edaes and



faces to describe 3D shapes. In Science we have plant reports, been writing our own summarising our learning from our plants unit. In PE, we have been practising balancing using different body parts during our Gymnastics sessions.

WHAT WE WILL BE DOING IN SCHOOL NEXT WEEK

Nurserv

Next week we will continue with the Jack and the Beanstalk story and will focus on acting and retelling the story.

Reception Next week we are going to innovate The Enormous Turnip story and make up our own version by changing the turnip to a different vegetable and also some of the characters.

In English, we will be continuing to write our innovated versions of the adventure Year 1 story 'Tom and the Island of Dinosaurs' changing the characters and animals. In Maths, we will be continuing to develop our multiplication knowledge by working through problems. In Science, we will be identifying animals as carnivores, herbivores and omnivores by their body characteristics. In History, we will be looking at the three dinosaur periods. In Computing, we will be getting the Beebots out.

English: We will writing our own individual versions of 'Where the Wild Year 2 Things Are'. We will using our own characters and settings.

Maths: We will be practising applying our Maths skills and learning to different problems and understanding problem solving language.

Topic: We will be starting our new Science unit; Living things and their habitats.

CHALLENGES

Please spend time with your child to explore this week's challenge. The teachers will talk to the children about what they have learnt at home every Friday.

Nursery:

With a grown-up, play a listening game. Adult says 'I went to the farm and I saw a c-a-t...' – instead of saying the animal name, split the word up into its letter sounds. Encourage your child to blending the sounds together and say the word cat. Repeat for other animal. Please **do not** use alphabet letter names for this activity.
