WHAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING IN SCHOOL THIS WEEK

Nursery

What a lovely end to our week (shame about the weather) with all the children and their families participating in our Sports Days. The children were really excited and have all been practising really hard throughout the week.



Reception

This week we have written our own versions of the story Farmer Duck. In maths we have been counting amounts larger than 20 and grouping them in tens to help with this.



Year 1

In English we completed our dinosaur non fiction books by adding photos and a contents page. In Maths we revisited addition strategies using 'Think 10' and partitioning the tens and ones. In Science we created our own mythical creatures using parts of different animals, before thinking about the diet and what the new animal would be able to do. In Computing, we continued to create and debug algorithms using a character and game board.



Year 2

We have had a very busy week. We thoroughly enjoyed taking part in Sports Day on Wednesday. We have been practicing our play ready for the performance next week. On Thursday we went to the Juniors to meet our new teachers, which was very fun! We would just like to say how proud we are of the children and what a joy it has been to teach them!
