WHAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING IN SCHOOL THIS WEEK

Nursery

We have had a really enjoyable week exploring inside and outside. The children have been playing with the toys in all the different areas of Nursery. We are beginning to organise our new key groups.



Reception

This week the children have continued to learn the classroom routines and each class have created their own class charter of what is expected in a safe and happy classroom. They also did a wonderful job at creating their own self-portraits.



In English we looked at our first text 'Handa's Surprise'. In Maths, we have used the language of more and fewer to compare sets of objects. In Art, we compared the work of artists Piet Mondrian and Bridget Riley. In Science, we named the parts of our bodies through drawing, writing and singing. In RE we thought about how we show thankfulness and in PSHE we revisited our Zones of Regulation.





Year 2

This week in English we were introduced to our new text 'Where the Wild Things Are'. In Maths we looked at counting to 100 in 10s. We were introduced to one of the figures we will be focusing on this term 'Florence Nightingale'. In Science, we looked at parts of a plant including

WHAT WE WILL BE DOING IN SCHOOL NEXT WEEK

Nursery

Next week we will be looking into mirrors and talking about our facial features. We will be drawing and painting pictures of ourselves and singing head shoulders knees and toes.

Reception Next week we will be talking about the different types of emotions (happy, sad, angry and worried) and introducing the children to the Zones of Regulation.

Year 1

In English, we will be unpicking our story of 'Handa's Surprise' through drama and answering questions. In Maths, we will be ordering numbers and estimating where numbers would go on a number track. In Geography we will look at where Watford is on a map of Great Britain and where it is relative to London. In PSHE we will be talking about what makes us feel safe and we will be thinking about being safe in school and the people we can talk to if we are worried about anything. In art we will be looking at expressing our views on art work especially the works of Piet Mondrian and Bridget Riley.

Maths: We are going to be looking at numbers to 100 Year 2

English: We are going to be learning about the different types of sentences (command, exclamation, question and statement) and understanding how to use commas in a list.

Topic: We are going to be recapping the continents of the world and learning the names of the world's oceans and seas.
