Reminders

Please do not send your child into school with medicine without filling in the appropriate form from the office. The staff will not be able to administer medication without it. We are seeing a lot of children with hayfever symptoms, it is advisable to administer an all day Antihistamine before school if your child suffers from hayfever.

As the weather is so hot please make sure that your child has a sun hat and water bottle with them every day. Sun cream should be applied before coming to school, this should be an all day cream as staff cannot reapply cream for the children.

Please make sure you take your child to the cloakroom at drop off time each day and do not leave them at the gate to walk in on their own.

We have had another case of head lice—Please check your child's hair and if you do find any signs of head lice or nits, make sure you treat them (and other family members if necessary).

WHAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING IN SCHOOL THIS WEEK

Nursery

This week we have continued talking about people who help us and have focused on the role of a dentist and how we need to take good care of our teeth.



Year 1

In English we boxed up our Tiger text, starting to unpick how a non-fiction text is split up and looked at using the text to answer comprehension questions. In Maths we looked at shapes and how to divide and colour halves and quarters. We had a fab day at Paradise Wildlife Park, looking at all the animals and dinosaurs! The children did so well, but obviously the best bit was lunch! In

Geography we looked at naming the seven continents of the world.



Reception

This week we have consolidated our learning about doubles and also identified half of an amount. We have looked at photos from our farm trip and wrote some sentences about the animals we saw there.



Year 2

In Science, we have been learning about the needs of baby animals and how

they are similar to the needs human babies have. In Maths we have been practising reading clock times and drawing clock hands. In English, we have been sequencing our class information report and making a writing toolkit.



WHAT WE WILL BE DOING IN SCHOOL NEXT WEEK

- **Nursery** Next week we will be focusing our learning linked to the story Picnic by John Burningham, we will be using prepositional language, talking about healthy foods and when playing we will be creating our own imaginative journey and having pretend picnics. What would you take on a picnic? Where would you go?
- **Reception** In literacy we will be acting out the story Farmer Duck and start thinking about our own story maps. In maths we will begin to work on identifying odd and even numbers.
- **Year 1** Next week in English we will be starting to think about innovating our Tiger text to create a Dinosaur non fiction text. In Maths we will be continuing to look at fractions and we will be looking at capacity. In Geography we will be identifying the seven continents of the world on a map. In Design and Technology we will continue to make our final moving pictures.
- Year 2 English: We are going to be learning about how to use different sentence starters.
 Maths: We will be learning how to answer time related word problems.
 Topic: We will be learning more about Queen Victoria and the main events of her life and reign.
