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## WHAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING IN SCHOOL THIS WEEK

#### Nursery

This week we have been reading and exploring the story of goldilocks and the three bears, we have also been learning the actions to the song and building the story into our role play



Year 1

In English, we acted out the story of 'The Three Little Pigs' and hot seated the wolf by asking him questions we had written. In Maths, we have been learning about doubling and halving and how our knowledge of odd and even numbers can determine whether a number can be halved. In Science, we identified the parts of a tree and in Geography, we begun looking at the capital city of England 'London' and identifying the River Thames as a



## Reception

This week we have continued with our learning about The Gingerbread Man. We were very excited to bake our own Gingerbread Man biscuits, we worked together to add actions to our story and labelled some of the characters from the story.



Year 2

This week in English we have been learning about apostrophes and how we can use them to show possession. In Maths we have been learning about money and using our knowledge to solve addition and subtraction calculations involving money. In Geography, we started our 'Poles Apart' unit and located the North and South Pole on a map.



## WHAT WE WILL BE DOING IN SCHOOL NEXT WEEK

- **Nursery** Next week we will be looking at sizes small, medium, and big following on from our goldilocks story.
- **Reception** Next week, we are continuing to explore our story, thinking about beginning, middle and end of the story, writing short sentences about each part. In Maths, we are going to look at how many objects are in a group and thinking about how many in total (2 groups).
- **Year 1** In English we will continue to look at the 3 Little Pigs. We will be especially looking at adjectives and the settings of the story.

In Maths we will be studying 2D and 3D shapes.

In Geography we will be looking at the human features in London especially the tourist attractions like Buckingham Palace, 02 and the London eye. In RE we will be looking at the Christian home and we have a special visitor from Well Spring coming to speak. In PSHE we will be thinking of steps towards reaching our goals.

Year 2 Maths: We are going to be learning about comparisons using units of measure. English: We are going to be creating a class innovated version of Jack and the Beanstalk. Topic: We are going to be learning about materials and their properties in Science.
