# Nursery

This week the children have been introduced to the Zones of Regulation and the different emotions. They have discussed what makes them feel happy, sad, worried, and angry.




# Year 1

In English, we unpicked our story of 'Handa's Surprise' through drama and answering questions. In Maths, we started to think about the sequence of number using the language of more and fewer. In Geography we looked at where Watford is on a map of the United Kingdom and where it is relative to London. In PSHE we talked about what makes us feel safe and the people we can talk to if we are worried about anything. In Art we looked at expressing our views on the art work of Piet Mondrian and Bridget Riley.



# Year 2

In Maths we have been exploring numbers up to 100, looking at regrouping. In English, we have been looking at different types of sentences to support us with our writing. In Geography we looked at the continents of the world. In PE we have been learning skills to use in football.



# WHAT WE WILL BE DOING IN SCHOOL NEXT WEEK

Nursery

The children will continue to talk about their sense of sight, we will read the story Brown Bear, Brown bear what can you see and will be identifying and sorting objects by their colours.

**Reception** Next week in Maths we will be singing number songs and playing subitising games. We will also be looking at the story Peace at Last by Jill Murphy.

In English, we will be looking at how to correctly construct a sentence with nouns Year 1 and verbs and capital letters, finger spaces and full stops using our text of Handa's Surprise. In Maths, we will be using our knowledge of the sequence of number to order numbers and place them on a number track. In Geography we will go on a small local walk to look at the location of our school in relation to the field and spotting human features. In PSHE we will be thinking about how facial expressions

can portray our emotions and how they fit in with our zones of regulations.

Maths: We are going to be looking at place value. Year 2

English: We are going to be working together to innovate 'Where the Wild Things

Topic: We are going to be learning about who Florence Nightingale was.
