### WHAT WE WILL BE DOING IN SCHOOL NEXT WEEK

- We will be retelling the story 'Picnic' by John Burningham and designing our own Nursery picnic menus.
- Reception Next week we will be writing some captions for pictures from the story Farmer Duck.
- In Maths we will be consolidating our knowledge of number, place value and how to Year 1 add and subtract using known number facts. In English we will be starting to write our innovation of our non fiction text to create a dinosaur non-fiction book. In Geography we will look at the names of all the five oceans. In Science we will be looking at amphibians. In PSHE we will be talking about the PANTS rules; about keeping our privates private.

**English:** We will be learning about different grammar techniques such as Year 2 joining clauses with 'but' and adding the –est suffix to root words. **Maths:** We will be applying our knowledge of mathematic skills to word problems. **Topic:** We will be learning how to use some of the woodwork tools safely such as clamps and wooden rods.
