# WHAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING IN SCHOOL THIS WEEK

#### Nursery

This week we have continued with our retelling of the Three Little Pigs and in our maths learning have been copying, continuing and making patterns with two attributes. (eg: red, blue, red, blue **or** banana, apple, banana, apple **or** square, triangle, square, triangle).



# Year 1


In English we started to write our own versions of 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears'. In Maths, we looked at some different types of problem solving. In History, we looked at

the journey that the Titanic took on their fateful voyage and plotted the journey on a map. In Science, we made a plant using foods we eat. In Art



we learnt how to add black to a colour to create different shades. As part of Easter day, we learnt why Christians celebrate Palm Sunday. This week we have started innovated the story of The Cat's Breakfast by changing some of the settings or/and characters and had a go at writing a plan for our new story which we will be independently writing next week. In Maths, we have been really busy thinking of different ways to make a number and also writing the number sentences. Eg 6+3=9

### Year 2

In English we have been innovating and writing our own set of instructions, making sure to use the correct adverbs of time. In Maths, we have been looking at different strategies for division. On Thursday, we had a very exciting and interesting visit from the local Fire Station, where we learnt lots of important safety facts. We hope you all enjoyed eating the super salads the children worked hard making!





#### WHAT WE WILL BE DOING IN SCHOOL NEXT WEEK

- **Nursery** We will be learning about what happens during the season of spring and talking about Easter time. This will involve beginning to know the names of baby animals and flowers that we see in spring
- **Reception** Next week we will be learning about the Christian celebration of Easter. We will find out more about how and why Easter is celebrated and enjoy some Easter activities. After half term, we will be introducing our topic of 'Our Garden', thinking about how plants grow.
- **Year 1** In English, we will be finishing our innovated versions of Goldilocks and the Three Bears and independently writing about the Titanic. As part of our History, we will be having our Titanic workshop! In Computing and Maths we will be looking at how to arrange data to answer questions. In PSHE we will be looking at how to cross the road safely.
- Year 2English: We are going to be looking at poetry.Maths: We are going to be focussing on division, looking at remainders.Topic: We are going to be making our clay portraits in the style of Picasso.
