# Nursery

We have been really impressed with the

children retelling of their own Jack and Beanstalk the stories.



# Reception

This week the children have worked so hard at writing their own version of 'The Enormous Turnip', we used our innovated story plans to create our own versions of The Enormous Turnip. In maths we looked at teen numbers by using ten and some more with different manipulatives such as numicon, beadstrings and

counters on tens frames. We released and said goodbye to all of our butterflies this week.



# Year 1

In English, we were independently planning and writing our own adventure stories. In Maths, we looked at the language of sharing and worked out division problems. In DT, we redesigned our moving pictures and thought about changing the material they are made out of and the way we add colour. In Science, we will had a mammal visitor come

to visit, a dog called Dexter. In History made dinosaur fossils out of salt dough, pasta or straws.



# Year 2

We innovated our own version of the text 'Where the Wild Things Are'. We are so proud of the children, the stories were really a joy to

read! In Maths we worked our collaborative and problemlearning solving skills. In PSHE we discussed what a secret is and when something is considered a secret. The



children have worked hard this half term and enjoyed their reward afternoon this week.

#### WHAT WE WILL BE DOING IN SCHOOL AFTER HALF TERM

Nursery

We will be starting the topic 'People Who Help Us' we will focus on keeping healthy and the job role of doctors, nurses, paramedics, dentists, opticians and hairdressers. We will have a doctor's role play where we will be taking care of our teddies and dolls.

Reception After half term in Maths we will be focusing on doubling and halving amounts. In English we will be focusing on a new story, 'Farmers Duck' looking at the characters, setting and any tricky words within the text.

- In RE we will be holding a Buddha day and we will be looking at the Buddhist faith. Year 1 In PSHE we will be looking at the life cycle of a frog and at the human life cylcle. In D and T we will be making our final moving picture. In History we will be thinking about what happened to the dinosaurs and how they became extinct.
- **English:** Looking at the features of a non-fiction report Year 2 Maths: We are going to be reviewing our mental calculation techniques **Topic:** We are going to be taking part in a Victorian Day (8<sup>th</sup> June)
