




Reception

In Literacy we have started writing about the

beginning, middle and end of our Farmer Duck story and our teachers were really impressed with our sentences. In Maths we have continued to explore the number pattern of odd and even numbers in number lines and even 100 squares. We have



also enjoyed meeting our new Year 1 teachers.

Year 1

In Maths we consolidated our knowledge of number, place value and how to add and subtract using known number facts. In English we started to write our innovation of our non fiction text to create a dinosaur non-

fiction book. In Geography we identified the five oceans. In Science, we learnt about the properties of amphibians. In PSHE we talked about the PANTS rules; about keeping our



privates private. In Art we looked at the sculptures created by Franz West.

Year 2

This week we have been very busy in Year 2. In English, we have been learning about grammar rules and applying them to our writing. In Maths, we have been applying our previously taught knowledge to word problems. On Thursday we had a very exciting visit to the Junior School, where the children were able to have a tour around the

school. We have been very busy rehearsing for our end-of-year production.



WHAT WE WILL BE DOING IN SCHOOL NEXT WEEK

Nursery

Next week we will be thinking and talking about the police and how they can help us. We will be looking at their vehicles, uniforms and the equipment that they use.

Reception We are looking forward to innovating our Farmer Duck story by changing some of the characters. In maths we are going to count and look at numbers beyond 20.

In Maths we will using our knowledge of number to practice a variety of skills. In English we will continue to write our Dinosaur non fiction books. In Geography we will identify which parts of the world are hot and cold based on how close they are to the equator. In Science, we will be sorting animals into their animal group, based on their properties. In PSHE, we will identifying male and female body parts.
