Reception, Year 1 & Year 2 start at 8.55am (doors open from 8.45am)


Nursery starts at 8.30am (morning / all day) or 12.30pm (afternoon) - please arrive on time as it's just as important for Nursery as School to be punctual!

#### WHAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING IN SCHOOL THIS WEEK

#### Nursery

This week we have enjoyed the story The Three Billy Goats Gruff we have identified

and talked about the characters and what they did in the story. We have pretended to be the goats or troll and practised saying key phrases from the story like "Who's that trip trapping over my bridge"



#### Reception

This week we have been creating our own versions of The Gingerbread Man, making a story plan with our own characters and a different setting. In maths, we have been finding the total of two numbers, using counting to find out how many altogether. We have practised writing number sentences to show our working.



#### Year 1

We have started to innovate our own version of the 3 little pigs, changing the characters and the houses. In Science, we identified how plants start growing from seeds and bulbs and we predicted what they

might grow into. In Geography, we named and identified the seas that surround the United Kingdom. In Maths, we unpicked the language of doubling and halving



linked to odd and even numbers.

#### Year 2

We innovated the story Jack and the Beanstalk



as a class. In Maths we explored written subtraction methods. In Science we worked as a team to design our model houses, we explored different materials and discussed their properties. In Geography we explored the human and

physical features of London.

#### WHAT WE WILL BE DOING IN SCHOOL NEXT WEEK

Nursery

We will continue to build upon the children's learning connected to The Three Billy Goats Gruff and will be encouraging them to recall and sequence the events in the story.

**Reception** Next week, we will be using our story map of our own Gingerbread Man story to write some story sentences.

Year 1 In English we will continue to write our innovated versions of The Three Little Pigs, before independently planning and writing our own traditional tale. We will also be going on our trip to the church to find out how people are welcomed to the Christian religion and celebrating Vasiakhi day. We will also be celebrating Safer Internet day where we will be thinking how to keep ourselves safe using technology.

Year 2 English: We will be continuing to innovate the story of 'Jack and the Beanstalk' by changing the characters and the villain in the story.

Maths: In Maths we are going to be exploring word problems. Topic: We are going to be learning all about Samuel Pepys.

Can you tell someone at home the story of the Three Billy Goats Gruff? You may like to create your own troll, it could be a puppet, picture, collage, painting or model.


#### Reception:

Please see spellings for this week.


Can you create a poster to showcase 'doubling' and 'halving'? You could draw pictures on there, write the word, use objects, write number sentences.
