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WHAT WE WILL BE DOING IN SCHOOL NEXT WEEK

- Next week we will be focusing on the story Jack and the Beanstalk. We will be Nurserv talking about the characters and the events within the story.
- Reception Next week we will continue to observe and learn about caterpillars. We will be writing part of the enormous turnip.
- In English, we will be starting to innovate the story of 'Tom and the Island of Year 1 Dinosaurs', changing the characters and settings. In Maths, we will be continuing with multiplication looking at how arrays (picture representations) can support our understanding. In Science, we will be identifying reptiles and having a small reptile visitor! In D&T we will be evaluating our mock moving pictures and thinking about how we could improve them.

English: We will planning our own independent versions of 'Where the Wild Year 2 Things are'. **Maths:** We are continuing to learn about fractions. **Topic:** We will be starting our new unit of Science; Living things and their habitats.
