WHAT WE WILL BE DOING IN SCHOOL NEXT WEEK

HOMEWORK CHALLENGES

Nursery:

Can you draw 1 or 2 objects around the house. You could draw the objects and bring your picture in to show us.

Reception:

What can you find out about transport and journeys? You might want to record your research with drawings, photos, labels or even a sentence.

Year 1:

How quickly can you fill out the number bonds to 10 on the bar models? These must be memorised in order to help our mental maths! Please practise or if your child already knows them, can they write the number sentence to match and begin to think of how they can help work out number bonds to 20? E.g. 2+8=10, so 12+8=20

Year 2:

Research why we celebrate Pancake Day. Can you design a pancake with your favourite toppings?
