NURSERY NEWS

The topics for the Summer Term are 'Me and My Outdoor World' and 'People Who Help Us'. We are excited to be learning more about our garden by growing plants, vegetables and learning more about the mini-beasts we might find. We will be learning more about the life-cycle of a chicken and have a really amazing opportunity as we will be looking after and hatching our own chicks from eggs.

The second half of the Summer Term we will be learning about People Who Help Us with our everyday activities and within the community. We are looking for community visitors such as police, vet, doctor, firefighter, dentist, hair dresser, to visit and speak about their job please let us know if you work in such areas and could help.

We also will have an exciting experience of an animal farm coming to visit our nursery. We will be able to touch, feed the animals and have the opportunity to meet and speak to a farmer.

It is important to remember to inform us when dropping off your child if you have made arrangements for another adult to collect your child and they must know the **password**. If this is not possible please call the school office in advance so they have time to get the message to us.

Please be aware that due to the safeguarding of all children there is to be no use of mobile phones or personal cameras in the nursery area by parents or carers.

On Mondays we will continue Super Star Sports PE sessions with Coach James. We are also going to be taking part in Relax Kids with Mel Which is about mindfulness and will be focusing on our different types of feelings. We advise that children wear tracksuit bottoms, or leggings. **They also need to wear shoes they can remove and put back on independently eg: velcro.**

In each Key Group area we display children's special 'wow' moments and home learning challenges. Please take time to share their achievements as it makes them feel really special. A 'wow' and 'special moment' can be about anything they do outside of school.

Please practise good teeth hygiene and help your child know the importance of brushing teeth and visiting the dentist.
