WHAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING IN SCHOOL THIS WEEK

Nursery

This week we learnt about the role of a farmer, looked at our phonics, sounds and focused on the number 4. The children explored with the new toy diggers and looked at tractors. We also looked at our concept cat word 'on'.



Reception

In PE we imagined that we went on a bus journey and travelled safely around the space pretending we are the drivers or passengers. We have also created our own Mother's day cards trying to show our mummies how much we appreciate them. The children and Teachers all really enjoyed World Book Day and it was wonderful to see all of the wonderful costumes.



Year 1

This week we celebrated World Book Week and looked at the character of Goldilocks. In Maths we did a tally chart showing our lunch choices. In History we looked at sources that show us evidence of the importance of Queen Elizabeth II, such as stamps and coins. In Science, we learnt the parts of a flowering plant and checked on our Marigolds that we planted.



Year 2

This week we have been learning about problem-solving in maths and looking at strategies to help us. In English, we have been exploring Little Red Riding Hood. In Geography, we learnt about the equator. On Friday we celebrated International Women's Day.



WHAT WE WILL BE DOING IN SCHOOL NEXT WEEK

Nursery

We will be focusing on the number 5 and new concept cat 'same/different'. We will also be making scarecrows using our cutting skills.

Reception

Next week, we will be looking at healthy foods and unhealthy foods in PSHE. In Maths we will be ordering numbers and placing them correctly in order, explaining which number goes before and which comes after. We will also be inviting children to bring in a bike or scooter to school. The children will be encouraged to talk about their vehicle and to ride it around the school playground.

Year 1

In English, we will be innovating the story of Goldilocks and the Three Bears to our own characters. In Maths, we will be looking at coins and their values and beginning to count in 2s, 5s and 10s. In History we will be looking at a timeline of Queen Elizabeth II. We will be thinking about her long reign and her significance as a ruler to our country and around the world. In D and T we will be looking at sliders. We will have a visitor who will explain the main aspects of the Muslim faith.

Maths: We will be exploring telling the time
English: We will be innovating our class text
Topic: We will be learning about the Easter Story

HOMEWORK CHALLENGES

Please spend time with your child to explore this week's challenge. The teachers will talk to the children about what they have learnt at home every Friday.

Nursery:

Can you find objects that start with the sound 'M', 'A', 'S' ?

Reception:

Can you look at different types of maps with your child for example, the world map and identify significant countries to your family. Encourage your child to remember where they live and in which country they are living. You may like to look at Google Earth and look for your house and other familiar places. Or share maps that you may followed at tourist places like the farm or even train maps like the underground. Also this could include looking at electronic maps like satnav's. Talk to you child about why we need maps.

Year 1:

Can you have a look at some of the coins and notes we use and think about their value? How many ways can you make 10p? How many ways can you make 20p?
