WHAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING IN SCHOOL THIS WEEK

<p style="text-align: center;">Nursery</p> <p>This week we have continued with our retelling of the Three Little Pigs. During our Super Star Sports session this half term we have been learning to use a tennis racket to balance a ball and hit the ball.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;">Reception</p> <p>This week's activities on transportation involved storytelling, role play, and hands-on learning to improve children's understanding of trains, bridges, and tunnels. Discussions and role play supported language development, while we explored the number concepts of one more and one less, strengthening their maths understanding of number order.</p> 
<p style="text-align: center;">Year 1</p> <p>In English we have been continuing to write our innovated version of Goldilocks and the Three Bears. In Maths this week we have been showcasing our mathematical knowledge. In History this week we have been discussing Queen Elizabeth's Platinum Jubilee. In Science, we looked at the parts of the plant we eat and created a plant out of fruits and vegetables.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;">Year 2</p> <p>This week in Year 2 we have had a fantastic week! In English, we innovated our class text and changed it to 'How to trap a mermaid'. In Maths, we have been delving further into division and learning how to link multiplication and division. In Science we wrote about the progress we saw in our bulbs and bean plants. We had a lovely day celebrating Eid day in school this week!</p> 

WHAT WE WILL BE DOING IN SCHOOL NEXT WEEK

- Nursery** We will be learning about what happens during the season of spring and talking about Easter time. This will involve beginning to know the names of baby animals and flowers that we see in spring.
- Reception** Next week we will expand the transport theme by using books about boats, linking water transport to bridges and tunnels, and including hands-on science activities like floating and sinking. We will encourage exploration, critical thinking, and language skills.
