WHAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING IN SCHOOL THIS WEEK

Nursery

This week we have introduced the story of the Three Little Pigs. We have been developing our imaginative play within the outdoor kitchen area and have been making meals in the café. We have introduced a take away counter for drinks, cakes and pastries. If you have any old cake tins, baking trays or large kitchen

utensils such as spatulas or whisks that you no longer need and are happy to donate them, we could use them in our play.



This week we continued to learn about transport. We used the story 'The Train Ride' as inspiration and a stimulus to start the week off. We discussed about what they know about trains, any experiences they have had with them. We encouraged role play in our train station role play area with the adult modelling the language and acting buying/selling tickets and making a journey on a train. In Topic we learnt about bridges and tunnels.



Year 1

In English we have been busy planning our stories before we start writing them next week. We have been designing some special things for Mother's Day. In maths, we have been exploring multiplication. In Science we explored whether we can eat plants and what parts we can eat. On Friday we celebrated Red Nose Day.



Year 2

This week in English we innovated our class set of instructions. We chose a new mythical creature to catch as part of these instructions. In Maths we have been linking multiplication to repeated addition and understanding that multiply can also mean 'lots of' or 'groups of'. In Science we looked at vehicles and decided which materials were appropriate to use when making a car, linking it to their properties. In DT we assembled our frames for our vehicles and used triangles to support the frame.

WHAT WE WILL BE DOING IN SCHOOL NEXT WEEK

Nurserv

We will be developing our Three Little Pig storytelling further trying to add more details and recall the events in order. Through our phonics teaching we are focusing on children beginning to hear words that begin with the same sound eg: mountain/monkey, apple/ant, snake/sun.

Reception We have looked at non-fiction books about boats. Next week we will include some fiction books and include some activities based around boats and water transport. In Maths we will find the whole of parts. We will also investigate whether objects float or sink. We will make boats using various materials. In the outdoor area we will role play being on boats and travelling in the sea.

English- Writing our own innovated stories of Goldilocks and the Three Bears Year 1 Maths- We will be learning about repeated addition

Topic- Exploring how our royal family are important across the world

English- We will be writing our own independent set of instructions on how to Year 2 catch a mythical creature of our own choice.

Maths- We will be continuing our learning on multiplication by spending more time looking at arrays.

Topic-In History we will be learning about how fire safety has changed since 1666 and how this has helped to change fire safety for the better in the present. In Art we will be continuing to develop our portraits in the style of Pablo Picasso. In PSHE we are thinking about the importance of safety and adult guidance when using medicine.

Nursery:

Reception:

Homework challenge Can you find out about a type of boat and draw a picture?. E.g. a pirate ship, a yacht, a rowboat, a canoe, a ferry or a raft



Year 1:

Next week at school we are going to be discussing Easter- Can you make/design an Easter bonnet or Easter garden?

Year 2:

We have been learning about suitable materials in Science. Can you find an object in your house, draw it and write a sentence about what it is made from and why it is made from that particular material/materials? For example, a window is made up mostly of glass as glass is transparent and allows us to see through it.
