# WHAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING IN SCHOOL THIS WEEK

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Nursery</b></p> <p>This week we have started to learn about what happens during the season of spring and talking about Easter time. We also looked at the names of baby animals like lambs, calves, piglets.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Reception</b></p> <p>We expanded our transport theme by exploring books about boats and connecting water transport to bridges and tunnels. Children engaged in hands-on science activities such as floating and sinking, which encouraged exploration and critical thinking. We also supported the development of their language skills through story discussion and descriptive words.</p> 
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Year 1</b></p> <p>In English, the children have been writing their own versions of Goldilocks and the Three Bears, creating new characters and settings. In Maths, we have been learning to recognise the value of different coins. In History, we explored how Queen Elizabeth contributed to the Commonwealth.</p> <p>In Science, we observed the signs of spring. In R.E. we learnt why Christians celebrate Easter.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Year 2</b></p> <p>This week in Year 2 we have been very busy! In English, we wrote our own instructions on how to trap our own mythical creature. In Maths, we showcased our learning from this term, our teachers were very impressed! In History we had a special visit from the local fire station who taught us all about fire safety in comparison to 1666. We completed our clay portraits in Art and can't wait to bring them home!</p> 

## WHAT WE WILL BE DOING IN SCHOOL NEXT WEEK

- Nursery** After half term, we will be introducing our topic of 'Me and my outdoor world' this will include learning about mini-beasts, plants and looking at the life cycle of a chicken.
- Reception** After the Easter holidays, we will introduce our new topic, 'Our Garden' and discover what children already know about growing plants using our topic box. Our stories will include \*The Tiny Seed\* by Eric Carle and \*The Enormous Turnip\*, which will lead into our Talk for Writing Unit. In Maths, we will focus on adding parts together to find the total.
- Year 1** In the first week back, we will be looking at early multiplication by counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. In English we will be looking at the features of a recount. We will be learning about Vaisakhi for our Sikh celebration day. In Science, we will be starting our topic of animals. If anyone has any interesting pets at home, please let us know!
- Year 2** **English-** We will be learning a new story...  
**Maths-** In Maths, we will be learning about fractions, finding halves, quarters and thirds of quantities.  
**Topic-** In Science we be starting our new unit on living things and their habitats. We will be starting a new unit in PSHE called Emotions Explorers, thinking about our emotions and how we can help ourselves when we are feeling sad/angry/worried.
