

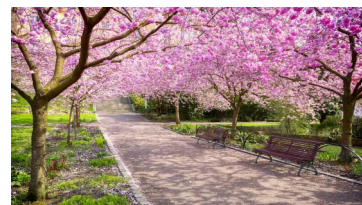

Reception, Year 1 & Year 2 start at 8.55am (doors open from 8.45am)

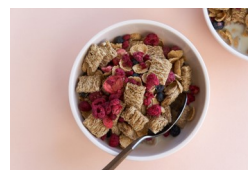
Nursery starts at 8.30am (morning / all day) or 12.30pm (afternoon) - please arrive on time as it's just as important for Nursery as School to be punctual!

WHAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING IN SCHOOL THIS WEEK

<p style="text-align: center;">Nursery</p> <p>This week we have continued with our retelling of the Three Little Pigs. During our Super Star sports session this half term we have been learning to bounce and catch a ball. We have been thinking and talking about all the things our Mummy's do for us and how they help us.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;">Reception</p> <p>This week we have looked at non-fiction boat books. We have included some fiction books and included some activities based around boat and water transport. In Maths we found the whole of the parts. We also investigated whether objects float or sink. We made boats using various materials. In the outdoor area we role played being on boats and travelling in the sea.</p> 
<p style="text-align: center;">Year 1</p> <p>This week in English we have been working incredibly hard writing our innovated stories, they have been amazing to read, we are so proud! In Maths, we have been revisiting previously taught learning. We evaluated our D&T projects on Wednesday and discussed what went well and what we would change next time. On Friday we celebrated Eid Day in school where some children shared how they celebrate. The children have worked hard making their cards for Mother's Day we hope you have a lovely Sunday celebrating.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;">Year 2</p> <p>This week in English we planned and wrote our own independent versions of 'How to trap a Giant'. We thought of some excellent ideas! We then edited our writing at the end. In Maths we have been learning about arrays. We have also been showcasing our learning from this term. In Science we made paper using recycled paper. We learnt about how important it is to reuse materials where we can. In PSHE we learnt about medicines and how important it is to have adult supervision when using them.</p> 

WHAT WE WILL BE DOING IN SCHOOL NEXT WEEK

- Nursery** We will be learning about what happens during the season of spring and talking about Easter time. This will involve beginning to know the names of baby animals and flowers that we see in spring.
- Reception** Next week we will focus on Easter and Spring celebrations. We will be learning about the Easter Story and will be singing Spring songs. We will be making Easter eggs and Easter cards. We will be carrying out an egg rolling investigation as well as decorating egg shapes with different patterns. In Maths we will continue to look at whole part models.
- Year 1** English- We are going to be learning about suffixes.
Maths- We will be looking at measures: mass, length and volume.
Topic- On Thursday we are going to be celebrating Easter in school and having an Easter Egg Hunt.
- Year 2** English- We will be having a fun writing week using lots of different stimuli such a videos and pictures.
Maths- We will be continuing our learning on multiplication and sharing all of the learning we have taken part in this half term.
Topic- In Art we will be completing our portraits in the style of Picasso. We will be having an Easter day where we learn about Easter and what it means for Christians. We will be having our Reward Afternoon this week too which will be an Easter egg hunt and Easter crafts.

Can you design an Easter bonnet? If you have time, maybe you could make one.

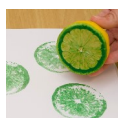


Year 1:
