Think to yourself how much socialising with another person have they had today. You can play simple games with your child such as 'Eye Spy', 'Alphabet Memory' or 'Would you rather' games. These games help the children to learn turn taking, and that sometimes they may win and sometimes they may lose. They will also have quality time with you, which is precious for young children. WHAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING IN SCHOOL THIS WEEK

Nursery

We are so proud of all your learning this half term. This week we have continued with pattern making and retelling the story of the Three Billy Goats Gruff.



Reception

This week we compared different Numicon, we compared numbers e.g. 5 is 2 more than 3.We tried to make playdough Arctic foxes. We also created frozen land art on the laptop as we celebrated e safety week. We drew pictures of the people that we can trust and those we can share with as a supportive network. We challenged ourselves to try to build Lego robots.



Year 1

This week in English, we explored acrostic winter poems, we used adjectives to write our own acrostic poem. In Maths, we have been exploring the language of problem solving and have been applying our knowledge to the problems. In Geography, we explored the human features of London. The children have had a fantastic half term, so on Thursday we enjoyed an afternoon of eating yummy pancakes.



Year 2

This week we have been writing our own Winter themed list poems in English. We used expanded noun phrases to help us write them. In Maths we have been learning to tell the time to o'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to the hour. We made our own clocks to help us! In History we learnt about all of the factors that made the Great Fire of London spread as far as it did.



WHAT WE WILL BE DOING IN SCHOOL NEXT WEEK

After half term we will introduce out new topic 'On the farm'. Nurserv

Reception After half term we will be introducing our new topic of 'Off We Go!' with a focus on vehicles and travel. We will be going down to the fence to watch the train, and take part in new train station role-play. We will be writing about how we travelled to school. In Maths we will be looking at whether children understand: in, on, under, next to, beside, above, below, on top of, between. We will be classifying different forms of transport and we will be measuring how far our vehicles travel. On the art table we will make a giant transport collage.

- English- We will be introduced to our new class text Year 1 Maths- We are going to be comparing numbers to 20 Topic- In science we are going to be planting Marigold seeds
- English-We will be learning about instructions and the importance of writing them Year 2 in the correct order.

Maths- We are going to begin learning about multiplication. Topic- We will be continuing our learning about the Arctic in Geography. In DT we will begin to make our vehicle bases using wood. We will have a visit from the local fire station to tell us all about fire safety now compared to 1666.
