

WHAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING IN SCHOOL THIS WEEK

<p style="text-align: center;">Nursery</p> <p>We have been looking more closely at some of the animals found on a farm, we have focused on their features and have been learning how to draw goats, cows, horses and sheep in more detail. Can you remember what their babies are called?</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;">Reception</p> <p>This week, children practiced directional language with map activities and obstacle courses, they learned about road signs through books and discussions, and celebrated world book day with fun literacy activities to promote reading.</p> 
<p style="text-align: center;">Year 1</p> <p>In English, we have continued to learn the text of Goldilocks and the Three Bears and described Goldilocks. In Maths, we have been looking at problems to solve the part or the whole using addition and subtraction. In D&T, we learnt how to join materials together using straws, pipe cleaners and tape. In Science, we have found out about the parts of a flowering plant.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Year 2</p> <p>This week we have been very busy with our learning! In English, we have been exploring the features of instructions, thinking carefully about how to write clear steps. We have been learning about using commas in a list. In Maths, we explored arrays and used them to help us understand multiplication. In Art, we created wonderful self-portraits inspired by the style of Pablo Picasso. In Geography, we continued our exciting project about the Arctic and Antarctica, learning more about these cold and fascinating parts of the world. On Thursday, we celebrated World Book Day and it was lovely to see the children dressed up and excited about reading. On Friday, we continued practising our recorder skills and are becoming much more confident with our notes. Well done Year 2 for another fantastic week!</p>

WHAT WE WILL BE DOING IN SCHOOL NEXT WEEK

- Nursery** Next week we will continue to learn about ducks and pigs. We will start to introduce the story called The Three Little Pigs. We will be looking at the key parts in the story and will explore the materials that they used to build their houses.
- Reception** Next week, we will use the book 'The Train Ride' by June Crebbin to inspire our activities, including role-playing selling train tickets at the station. Children will have opportunities to bring in scooters and bikes, build trains outside, and create chalk maps. There will also be a treasure hunt led by adults and a special activity to make Mother's Day cards.
- Year 1** In English next week, we will be innovating the story of Goldilocks and the Three Bears, changing the characters and setting as a whole class. In Maths, we will be continuing to look at problem solving with addition and subtraction. In D&T, we will be learning how to make structures more stable. In Science, we will be identifying common wild and garden plants with a plant identification key. In History, we will be finding out about the timeline of Queen Elizabeth II.
- Year 2** **English-** We will be revisiting expanded noun phrases and using 'box it up' to section our instructions
Maths- In Maths we are going to be exploring division strategies
Topic- We are going to be completing our vehicles in DT
