

WHAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING IN SCHOOL THIS WEEK

<p style="text-align: center;">Nursery</p> <p>This week we have been introducing the story of the Three Little Pigs. We have been developing our imaginative play and practised being the characters from the story building the houses and knocking them over.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;">Reception</p> <p>This week we have continued to learn about transport. The children have been riding their scooters or bikes. We have also been thinking about maps and journeys. We have been drawing pictures of our scooters and bikes. In Maths we have been learning to use number lines from zero to 10, using 5 as a benchmark.</p> 
<p style="text-align: center;">Year 1</p> <p>In English this week, we have been innovating the story of Goldilocks and the Three Bears and changing the characters and setting as a whole class. In Maths, we have looked at finding the difference. In Science, we have walked around the school grounds to identify some wild and garden plants. In D&T, we have learnt how to make a structure more stable.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;">Year 2</p> <p>This week in Year 2 we have been very busy with our learning. In English, we have been practising how to edit mistakes in our writing and remembering that mistakes help to show our learning. We have also been exploring bossy verbs and how they are used in instructions. In Maths, we have been learning about division, and trying different strategies to help us share numbers equally. In Science, we investigated the suitability of different materials for cars and discussed which materials would work best and why. We have also enjoyed getting creative by making Mother's Day cards. In RE, we learned about the Jewish celebration of Pesach and why it is an important festival. It has been a fantastic and busy week in Year 2!</p>

WHAT WE WILL BE DOING IN SCHOOL NEXT WEEK

- Nursery** We will be developing our Three Little Pig storytelling further trying to add more details and recall the events in order.
- Reception** Next week we will be continuing to learn about transport. We will use the story 'The Train Ride' as inspiration and a stimulus to start the week off. We will encourage discussions about what they know about trains, and any experiences they have had with them. The role play area will be a train station, with the adults modelling language of buying/selling tickets. In Topic we will be learning about bridges and tunnels. In Maths we will continue to look at number magnitude and 1 more/1 less than a number.
- Year 1** In English we will be continuing to write an innovated version of Goldilocks and the Three Bears with adjectives. In Maths, we will be showcasing our mathematical knowledge. In Science, we will be looking at the parts of the plants we eat. In R.E we will be learning about Eid.

- English-** In English, we are going to be writing our own set of class instructions.
- Maths-** In Maths, we will be continuing our learning on division. We will be learning about remainders and what happens when numbers don't divide equally. We will be learning how to apply our knowledge of division strategies to solve division word problems.
- Topic-** In Science we will be checking in on our tulip bulbs and our bean plants. We will be writing an update on what we have observed whilst they have been growing. In Art, we will be making clay self – portraits.
