# Please spend time with your child to explore this week's challenge. The teachers will talk to the children about what they have learnt at home every Friday.

#### Nursery:

#### Year 1:

Over the next half term in Science, we are going to be learning about different types of animals- these include, mammals, reptiles and birds. Over the next four weeks, we have a project for you to complete. We would like you to research your favourite type of animal. You may wish to create a fact file, mini book, create a 3D sculpture or poem (the choice is yours). When researching you may want to find out about their habitat, diet, what they look like, are they warm or cold blooded or any other fun facts.
