WHAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING IN SCHOOL THIS WEEK

<p style="text-align: center;">Nursery</p> <p>We have particularly enjoyed our outside area this week we have been focusing on different sensory play experiences by exploring using the natural resources like, bark, stones, sand, water. We have been developing our physical skills particularly our hand muscle by, pouring, digging, scooping, lifting, mixing, squeezing, etc. The children have amazed us with their imaginative play ideas and the storylines they have been creating in their play.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Reception</p> <p>This week we have continued our writing with the middle of our Farmer Duck story. In Maths we consolidated odd and even learning by exploring consecutive numbers and the odd / even patterns.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Year 1</p> <p>English- We planned an innovation of the story 'Peter Rabbit' Maths- We looked at balancing scales with addition calculations using more than/less than signs Science- We identified the features of summer PSHE- We learnt the 5 PANTS rules about keeping our private parts private</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Year 2</p> <p>This week Year 2 have been working so hard, despite the sunny weather! We have revisited the story of 'Pantosaurus' and discussed how important it is to feel safe and to tell a grown up if you're feeling worried or anxious. We used our painting skills in History to create watercolour paintings of Floella Benjamin – they look brilliant! In Science we thought about the needs for survival of minibeasts and designed our own bug hotel to encourage insects to visit the playground.</p>

WHAT WE WILL BE DOING IN SCHOOL NEXT WEEK

- Nursery** Next week we will be continuing our exciting theme of Firefighters. The children have already shown so much enthusiasm, and we're building on their curiosity.
- Reception** Next week we will finish our farmer duck writing. We will also have opportunity to doing some writing about pets. In Maths we will be focusing on counting in 10s.
- Year 1** English- We will be writing an innovation of 'Peter Rabbit'
 Maths- We will be revising addition and subtraction strategies
 Science- We will be comparing the four seasons
 Computing- We will be learning how to change sprites and adding given algorithms in Scratch Jr
 PSHE- We will be learning the correct names of male and female body parts
- Year 2** **English-** We are going to be researching a new animal to write our information reports.
Maths- We are going to be focusing on showing our working out when solving calculations.
Topic- In Science, we are going to be using our bug hotel designs to build bug hotels on the playground. We are going to be starting a new Year 2 project where we work in small teams to create a new imaginary island.
