WHAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING IN SCHOOL THIS WEEK

Nurserv

This week in nursery, we were learning all about firefighters, we have been talking about what firefighters do and how they help keep us safe. We have read stories and watched some video clips. The children were role playing by creating fire engines, using hoses, and dressing up in helmets and pretending to solve emergencies. Rescuing cats from trees was a particular favourite.



Year 1

This week in Year One we celebrated Titanic Day, the children fully immersed themselves into the experience and had such a wonderful day. We were impressed by all of the children's wonderful outfits, so thank vou! In English, the children have worked so hard to write their own versions of a recount. In Maths, we have been continuing to review numbers to 20 through worded problems.



Reception

This week on the writing and creative tables the activity was guite open ended to give the children the chance to show and use what they have learnt so far this year. In the Maths investigation area the children had the chance to count in tens. In the book and cosy area the children had a chance to look at Non-fiction & fiction books about farm, animals and animal care.





Year 2

This week we have had lots of fun creating our group projects. We designed an imaginary island in teams, decided the name of the island, where it was in the world and its climate. We began to design the island, deciding it's human and physical features such as mountains, volcanoes, beaches and shops. We had a brilliant time on our trip to Whipsnade Zoo and the children behaved amazingly. We learnt lots about animals and their habitats.



WHAT WE WILL BE DOING IN SCHOOL NEXT WEEK

- Next week we will focus on the role of a dentist and how we need to take good Nursery care of our teeth and an optician and how they help with our eyes. We will be reading and retelling the story 'Picnic' by John Burningham and when playing we will be creating our own imaginative journey and having pretend picnics. What would you take on a picnic? Where would you go?
- Next week they will look together at photos of their time in Reception. They will Reception talk about some of the favourite times they have had. They will look at some photos of their time n Reception and they will put them in order to create a timeline. Next week we will continue our theme of animals. On the writing and creative tables the activity will be guite open ended to give the children the chance to show and use what they have learnt so far this year. We will also be playing with Farmer Duck stick puppets and retelling the story.

English- we will be having a Poetry week Year 1 Maths- we will be reviewing all of our learning from Year One and completing a quiz. Transition- we will be visiting our new classroom with our new Teachers on Wednesday 9th July.

Next week we will be continuing with our island projects. We will be thinking Year 2 about the historical aspects of our island such as whether they have a royal family etc. We will be adding the final touches to our island designs ready to present our island to other teams. We will also be visiting the Junior school.
