

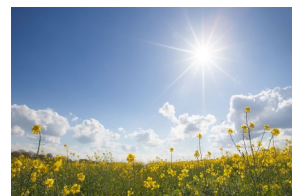

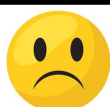

WHAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING IN SCHOOL THIS WEEK

Nursery

We have enjoyed reading the story the 'Picnic' and have been practising retelling the story. We have created our own picnic plates deciding on food we would take. We have created imaginary role play scenarios of going on adventures and setting up and have pretend picnics together. We have continued to embrace our wonderful outdoor learning spaces this week where the children really are developing their imaginations and creating storylines within their play.



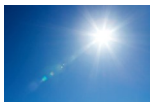
Reception

This week we all looked at photos of the children's time in Reception. We talked about some of the favourite times they have had. We used the photos to put them in order to create a timeline. We continued our theme of animals. On the writing and creative tables the activity was quite open ended to give the children the chance to show and use what they have learnt so far this year. We also played with Farmer Duck stick puppets and retelling the story.



Year 1

What a fantastic week we've had in Year One! In English, we've been revisiting our taught grammar skills. In Maths, we've been working on our 'Forget Me Not' activities to consolidate our understanding from the year. Science took us outdoors as we explored the features of summer. A real highlight was our End of Year Achievement Assembly on Wednesday – we were bursting with pride watching the children shine on stage. They truly are a pleasure to teach. We also had a lovely opportunity to spend some time with our new teachers this week.



Year 2

This week we decided the history of our island. We decided if any famous people had been born on our island or if our island had gone through any changes over the years. We then turned our island designs into 3D maps, using paint and arts and crafts materials. We added a key and a compass onto our 3D maps too. We visited the Junior school twice this week. We had a tour of the school from the Year 5 children and we got to visit our new classrooms!



WHAT WE WILL BE DOING IN SCHOOL NEXT WEEK

Nursery

Next week we will be continuing with the retelling of the 'Picnic' story and singing our favourite rhymes. In maths we are continuing to practise matching amounts and numbers together. Please remember to come and watch our Nursery Sing-A-Long on Friday 18th July.

Reception

Next week we will be doing some addition sums, and fill in the missing numbers when counting in tens. We will continue to write down our memories of Reception. On the art table we will make an end of year crown. On the playdough table we will make playdough ice-creams and lollies. We will Recap 4 seasons and what we know about them so far. We will explore and compare summer to the other seasons – temperature, weather, growth. We will ask children to make observations they have seen recently. We will also use small world to make summer scenes.

Year 1

English- we will be exploring summer poems
Maths- we will be exploring place value
Transition- we will be consolidating all our topic learning

Year 2

Next week we will be presenting our projects to the Year 1 children. We will be finishing our art sculptures and vehicles ready to take home. We will be performing our end of year play to the rest of the school and then finally to our families – we cant wait for you to see it!


