WHAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING IN SCHOOL THIS WEEK

Nursery

We had a postman come to visit and tell us about delivering letters. In maths we have focused on number sequences and putting them in order up to 10. In our outside environment we have been creating obstacle courses.



Reception

This week in Literacy, we have written our farm recounts which have been amazing! In Maths, we have really enjoyed counting and looking at numbers beyond 20. The children had their first transition session this week in which their new teachers came to see them in their current class and read them a story.



Year 1

This week in English we unpicked the features of a non-chronological report. In Maths we showcased our mathematical knowledge. In PSHE we learnt the correct terminology for male and female body parts. In History we explained why the Titanic's sunk. In Art, we completed our mosaic and collage Titanic pictures and we looked for signs of summer outside as part of our Science.

Year 2

This week we have had a very busy but fun week. On Tuesday, we were kindly treated to a talk from Sharon about the Windrush, the children learnt lots of interesting facts. On Wednesday we got to meet Miss Brookes the headteacher from the juniors. On Thursday we were treated to a tour of juniors by the Year 5 children. In English we were introduced to our new text 'Kassim and the Greedy Dragon'. In Maths we have been revisiting previous learning.

Nursery

We will continue to practice our songs for our end of year singing show. We will be having a visit from the refuse people to tell us about getting rid of rubbish. In maths we will be playing maths games that help us count up to 10.

Reception

The children will be having another transition day next week, where they will go up to their new classroom with their new teachers.
