

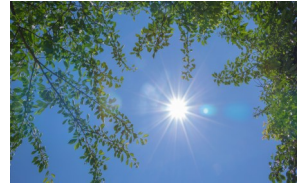

Keep furniture away from open windows so that children can't climb up to a window, even if it is on the ground floor. If you can install window catches (to limit how far they can open). 

Weather Update!

WHAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING IN SCHOOL THIS WEEK

<p style="text-align: center;">Nursery</p> <p>This week we have been learning about the police. We were talking about their job and when we might need their help. In maths we have been counting amounts and matching these to the correct numeral.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;">Reception</p> <p>This week we finished our farmer duck writing. We also had an opportunity to do some writing about pets. We compared numbers and looked at how to find the precise difference.</p> 
<p style="text-align: center;">Year 1</p> <p>English- We planned our own versions of Peter Rabbit Maths- We checked our knowledge of our Year 1 learning Science- We compared the weather and clothes we wear in each of the four seasons PSHE- We talked about how we have grown as a person</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;">Year 2</p> <p>We have had another lovely week of learning in Year 2! On Tuesday, the children made us the proudest teachers during our visit to Whipsnade Zoo. They were incredibly polite, respectful and represented our school beautifully throughout the day. In English, we worked together to write a class non-chronological report all about otters, using our knowledge of this text type. In Maths, we explored all four operations and discussed which methods were the most efficient for solving different calculations. We also continued our exciting Island Project, where we thought carefully about the rules we would have if we created our very own island.</p>

WHAT WE WILL BE DOING IN SCHOOL NEXT WEEK

- Nursery** We will be reading and retelling the story 'Picnic' by John Burningham and when playing we will be creating our own imaginative journey and having pretend picnics. What would you take on a picnic? Where would you go?
- Reception** Next week will be our last full week of Reception. We will continue our theme of animals. On the writing and creative tables the activity will be quite open ended to give the children the chance to show and use what they have learnt so far this year.
- Year 1**
 English- We will be writing our own versions of 'Peter Rabbit'
 Science- We will be comparing plants and what we do in each of the four seasons
 Computing- We will be creating our own race on Scratch Jr
 History- We will be creating posters to display our knowledge about Titanic.
- Year 2**
English- Researching an animal of our choice for our non-chronological report
Maths- We are going to be exploring the unknown in a problem
Topic- We are going to be continuing with our year group island projects. We will be creating a national anthem, deciding the history of our island and designing the island's flag.
