
## **Picnic days**

#### WHAT WE WILL BE DOING IN SCHOOL NEXT WEEK

- **Nursery** We will be retelling the story 'Picnic' by John Burningham and when playing we will be creating our own imaginative journey and having pretend picnics. What would you take on a picnic? - **Reception** Next week, we will be continuing with our hot task writing of the 'Farmer Duck' story. In maths, we will be using the hundred square to count in 5's, noticing the number patterns. The children will also be looking in their learning folders and talking about the all of their amazing work that they have done throughout the year.
