WHAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING IN SCHOOL THIS WEEK

Nursery

This week we have started to read the story Jack and the Beanstalk and are recalling characters and key events. In phonics we are playing and practising oral blending games. The adult says the word in sounds m-a-t and the children blend the sounds together and say the word mat.



Reception

This week in Maths we have been working really hard to find the missing whole and the missing part, using a variety of manipulatives to help us. We have also been observing our caterpillars, discussing the changes and logging these changes in our caterpillar diary. This week we have all had the opportunity to hold the chicks which the children really enjoyed. In English, we have innovated 'The Enormous Turnip' story ready to write our own version of the story.

Year 1

In Maths we looked had a go at multiplication problems. In English we wrote our own version of Rama and Sita changing the characters. In Geography, we found out about the characteristics of Wales and in R.E, we had Watford Trust in to talk to us about a Christian story of 'The Lost Sheep'.

Year 2

This week in Maths, we have been exploring fractions of shapes and focussing on finding 34. In English we have been innovating our own version of Hansel and Gretel, they have been a joy to read. On Thursday we were very lucky and had the opportunity to hold the chicks before we had to say goodbye to them.



WHAT WE WILL BE DOING IN SCHOOL NEXT WEEK

Nursery

Next week we will continue with the Jack and the Beanstalk story and will focus on acting and retelling the story.

Reception Next week, we will be finding out about spiders and learning interesting facts about them, we will have lots of activities set up for the children to do such as, making spider webs and playing spider doubles. We will also be planting our own sunflower seeds, discussing what they need in order to grow.

HOMEWORK CHALLENGES

Please spend time with your child to explore this week's challenge. The teachers will talk to the children about what they have learnt at home every Friday.

Nursery:

With a grown-up, play a listening game. Adult says 'I went to the farm and I saw a c-a-t...' – instead of saying the animal name, split the word up into its letter sounds. Encourage your child to blending the sounds together and say the word cat. Repeat for other animals. (You can change the focus eg: food, clothes, action words) Please **do not** use alphabet letter names for this activity. Reception:

Can you find out any interesting facts about Spiders?

You could bring in this information to school or write it as a sentence and bring it in to show us!

Year 1:

Year 2:
