### Half term

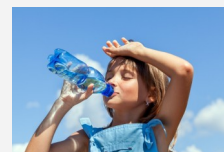
We have included at the end of the newsletter information about what you can do during half term in Watford. Have a lovely half term and we will see you back in school on Monday 1st June.



# WHAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING IN SCHOOL THIS WEEK

<p style="text-align: center;">Nursery</p> <p>Our broad beans have begun to grow, and the children were very excited to spot the first little shoots peeking through the soil. They have also enjoyed planting a variety of other vegetable seeds this week, learning how to care for them and talking about what plants need to grow.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;">Reception</p> <p>We continued building a bug hotel outside and introduced snails as our mini-beast focus. The children enjoyed reading 'The Snail Trail' and exploring Henri Matisse's 'The Snail' through 'painting with scissors'. In maths, we reinforced our understanding of teen numbers using various tools and materials.</p> 
<p style="text-align: center;">Year 1</p> <p>In English, we have been writing a class acrostic poem. In Science we looked at what animals eat and whether they are a herbivore, omnivore or carnivore. In Maths, we have been looking at the language of 'twice as many'. In History, we learnt about the main reasons as to why Titanic sank.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;">Year 2</p> <p>In English we planned and wrote our hot tasks for our independent writing. We then edited them for punctuation, adjectives and setting description. In Maths we learnt about equality in multiplication and division and learnt to balance calculations. In Science, we learnt about the life cycle of a frog and drew a cyclical diagram to represent it. In Geography we learnt about the human features of Jamaica and located them on a map.</p> 

## WHAT WE WILL BE DOING IN SCHOOL NEXT WEEK

- Nursery** We will be introducing our new topic, '**People Who Help Us**'. We'll begin by exploring how we keep ourselves healthy and the different people around school that help us.
- Reception** After half-term, our focus will be on the story 'Farmer Duck' and the theme of farms. The children will learn about identifying 'same' and 'different' groups. We will also start exploring doubles, such as  $1 + 1$  and  $2 + 2$ , in maths activities.

**English:** Introducing our new text of Peter Rabbit  
**Maths:** looking at division by sharing  
**Science:** sorting and classifying animals  
**Geography:** finding out the characteristics of Wales  
**PSHE:** life-cycles
- Year 2**  
**English-** We are beginning our new unit on non - chronological reports.  
**Maths-** We are going to be starting our unit on Geometry.
