Children must use a child car seat until they're 12 years old or 135 centimetres tall, whichever comes first.

All passengers must wear a seat belt even if they are in the back of the car. This is the law and the driver can be fined up to £500 and 3 penalty points if a child under 14 is not in the correct car seat or wearing a seatbelt whilst the vehicle is moving. Please insure that your child is in the appropriate seat to keep them safe.

WHAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING IN SCHOOL THIS WEEK

<p style="text-align: center;">Nursery</p> <p>This week we introduced our new topic 'People Who Help Us' we started to talk about different people who help us. Towards the end of the week we have started to focus on how we keep healthy. We have been using our new Doctors surgery role play and have been helping our toy teddies and dolls get better and keep healthy.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Reception</p> <p>This week our focus has been on the story 'Farmer Duck' and the theme of farms. In Maths the children have learnt about identifying 'same' and 'different' groups. We have done this using dominoes. We have started exploring doubles, such as 1 + 1 and 2 + 2.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Year 1</p> <p>This week, we went a bit Phonics mad! We have been revising all our sounds, spotting them in alien and real words and doing lots of different activities to help us read words with the sounds. In Maths, we have learnt about sharing to make equal groups. In Science, we found out the difference between wild animals and pets and what they need to be looked after. In Geography, we identified the characteristics of Wales.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Year 2</p> <p>It has been lovely welcoming the children back to school for our final half term of Year 2. This week in English, we were introduced to our new non-fiction text, a non-chronological report about giraffes, and have enjoyed learning fascinating facts about these amazing animals. In Maths, we have been exploring geometry and developing our understanding of shapes and their properties. In History, we discussed how and why people moved to Britain in 1948 and reflected on the experiences of those arriving as part of the Windrush generation. We also got creative in Art, where the children designed and made their own wire sculptures, showing great imagination and perseverance.</p>

WHAT WE WILL BE DOING IN SCHOOL NEXT WEEK

- Nursery** Next week we will be looking at the people who help us such as doctors, nurses and paramedics. We will also be practising for sports day. We look forward to seeing you come and cheer us on.
- Reception** Next week we will be looking a little more at farms and our farmer duck story, in preparation for our visit to Aldenham Country Park and farm on the Friday. In Maths we will be looking at doubles and halves. We will also be singing Old Macdonald had a farm, and learning some of the Makaton signs.
- Year 1** In English, we will be learning our new text of 'Peter Rabbit'. We will also be completing the Phonic Screening check. Please remember that this is normal practise for the children and they are used to reading alien and real words with us. We please ask that you do not share with them that it is a test.
 Geography: we will be looking at the human and physical features of Cardiff
 PSHÉ: Understanding how we have changed from a baby (don't forget to send in your baby photos!)
 Art: learning to create a 'mosaic' by tearing paper
- Year 2** **English-** We will be sequencing our giraffe reports, learning about compound words and revising different types of sentences.
Maths- We are going to be exploring all four maths operations.
Topic- In Geography we are going to be learning about the vegetation of Jamaica and comparing it to the vegetation of the UK. In Science we are going to be unpicking what a microhabitat is and learning more about microhabitats around our school.

HOMEWORK CHALLENGES

Please spend time with your child to explore this week's challenge. The teachers will talk to the children about what they have learnt at home every Friday.

Nursery:

Regularly play the phonics game 'Mummy/Daddy Says'. Encourage your child to listen as you say the sounds (Fred talk) for the action words. Eg: Mummy says **h-o-p**, **h-o-p**, encourage your child to say it with you **h-o-p** and then say the whole word hop, complete the action together. Other word ideas could be Mummy says **r-u-n**, **n-a-p**, **j-o-g**, **s-i-ng**, **h-u-g**, **s-i-t**. We hope you find this Parent Film helpful (set 1 letters) as it talks about how to say the letter sounds correctly when encouraging and saying the initial sounds heard at the beginning of words.

Reception:
