

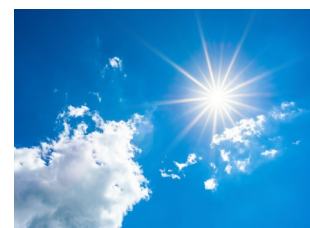

WHAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING IN SCHOOL THIS WEEK

<p style="text-align: center;">Nursery</p> <p>This week we have continued learning about <i>People Who Help Us</i>, with a focus on dentists. The children enjoyed exploring how dentists help us to look after our teeth. We have also been practising our Sports Day skills and finished the week with a fantastic Sports Day. It was wonderful to see the children taking part with such enthusiasm and joy.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Reception</p> <p>This week we started focusing on writing the beginning of the story Farmer Duck. In Maths we have been exploring whether numbers are odd or even and discussing how we know this, using our previous skills of halving and doubling.</p> 
<p style="text-align: center;">Year 1</p> <p>In English, we answered questions about Peter Rabbit. In Maths were looking at fractions (half and quarter) of shapes. As part of our History topic we truly enjoyed our Titanic day where we role played and created 1st or 3rd class bedrooms and dining rooms. Thank you for your support with Sports Day, we were so proud of all the children's participation and achievements.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;">Year 2</p> <p>Year 2 have been busy bees this week! We enjoyed showcasing our sports skills during Sports Day, we were all amazing team players! We have been thinking about transition to our new schools and completed 'all about me' fact files ready to share with our new Year 3 teachers. In PSHE we learnt about new things we accomplish at different stages of our lives. In Geography we learnt about fruits and vegetables that grow natively in Jamaica and learnt how they grow.</p>

WHAT WE WILL BE DOING IN SCHOOL NEXT WEEK

Nursery Next week, we will be learning about the important role of firefighters and how they help to keep us safe.

Reception We are looking forward to continue our writing with the middle of our Farmer Duck story. In Maths we are going to consolidate odd and even learning by exploring consecutive numbers and the odd / even patterns.

Year 1 In English we will be innovating the story of Peter Rabbit. In Maths we will be revising calculation strategies previously taught. In PSHE we will be learning about which parts of our body are private and the rules we need to follow with this, using the NSPCC Pantosaurous lesson. In Science, we will be identifying the features of summer.



Year 2 **English-** We will be focusing on the skill of locating and using evidence from the text to answer written comprehension questions.
Maths- We will be re visiting prior learning and recapping how to show our working out.
Topic- In Science we will be learning about how animals are suited to their habitats. In DT we will be designing our salads based on our food tasting session. In Computing we will be learning more about how to take a good photograph and how important it is to ask permission before taking someone's photograph.

Nursery:

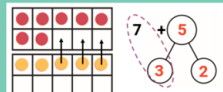
Reception:

Can you create a game involving odd and even? For example, rolling the dice and finding that amount of small objects. Can you pair up the objects? Are they odd or even? Or perhaps you could line up your toys in pairs to make even amounts?

Year 1:

Revisit 'Think 10' calculation strategy homework sheet.

WORKED EXAMPLE



7 + 5

I can regroup 5 to 'Think 10'.

I need 3 more to make 10.

Then I have 2 more to add.

$7 + 5 = 7 + 3 + 2$

$= 10 + 2$
