WHAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING IN SCHOOL THIS WEEK

Nursery

This week we have learned about the dentist and how to take care of our teeth, we have also started to paint pictures of people who help us.



Reception

In Literacy we have started writing about the beginning, middle and end of our Farmer Duck story and our teachers were really impressed with our sentences. In Maths we have been exploring whether numbers are odd and even and discussing how we know this, using our previous skills of halving and doubling.



Year 1

This week we wrote our own 5-part stories. In Maths we learnt to tell the time to o'clock and half-past. In History we learnt about the maiden voyage that the Titanic wanted to take in 1912. We had Buddhism day and we looked at what Buddhists believe, why they celebrate Vesak and its main symbols.



Year 2

On Tuesday we travelled to Whipsnade for our school trip, the children were all so well behaved and we are so proud of them. In English, we have been writing non-fiction reports on penguins. This week in Maths, we have been looking at features of shape.



WHAT WE WILL BE DOING IN SCHOOL NEXT WEEK

Nursery Next week we will carry on learning about people who help us in the community. We will also focus on extending our subitising skills and phonics.

Reception We are looking forward to innovating our Farmer Duck story by changing some of the characters. In Maths we are going to count and look at numbers beyond 20.

Year 1 In English: predicting our non-fiction text and giving reasons using 'because'
In Maths: recapping place value and addition and subtraction
In Science: We are going on our trip to Hertfordshire Zoo!
In PSHE we will look at the 'Pantasaurus' story and the need to keep our private parts private.

Year 2 Maths: We will be discussing right angles.
English: We will be writing reports on animals
Topic: We are going to be talking about the differences between each other

Nursery:

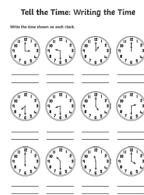
Can you think of objects that start with the sound 'u' and 'b'.

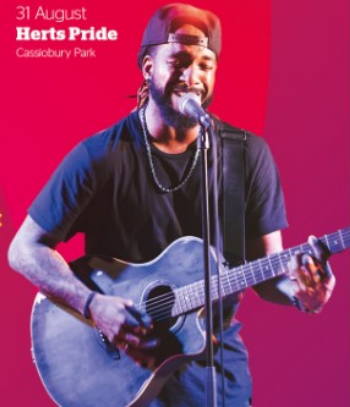
