## Children will learn:

- To understand sculpture as a form of 3D form.
- To manipulate different materials by cutting, kneading, shaping, rolling and pressing materials (paper, dough, clay).
- To develop art techniques to make a sculpture
- To design and create a piece of work in response to an artist using key techniques
- To create a sculpture using key techniques



#### Children will learn:

- To design a product with levers and sliders using a design criteria
- To select from a range of tools and understand health and safety rules
- To share ideas using models and mock ups with card and paper
