






Maths

Numbers beyond 10, including place value up to 20. We will continue to practise addition, subtraction, and use known number facts to solve new problems. They will also deepen their reasoning skills by explaining their thinking orally and in their recording


Key learning areas:

- Place value of teen numbers
- Exploring doubling and halving
- Adding and subtracting using the 'think 10' strategy
- Understanding equality and balance (different calculations with the same value)
- Recognising and using coins
- Counting in 2s, 5s, and 10s
- Beginning multiplication and division



Ideas for Home:

- Number bonds to 10
- Correct numeral formation especially teens
- Ordering the days of the week
- Ordering the months of the year
- Quick recall of 1 more and 1 less than any number to 20
- Counting forwards and backwards to 100
