English

This term we will be looking at different genres of books, including narrative stories, reciting poetry and non fiction recounts, using the Talk 4 Writing approach.

We will be taking part in grammar lessons based on punctuation, suffixes and common exception words.

We will have a daily focus on Phonics in Year 2 where the children will learn sounds and take part in guided reading. We will also have weekly whole class guided reading session where each child will be heard reading a book.

Please continue to hear your child read their book every day and please remember to sign their reading record books. This will be monitored regularly.

<u>Maths</u>

O-100 and looking at different subtraction and addition methods.

We will be continuing to develop the children's use of manipulatives and equipment to help them work more independently to calculate answers to questions.

Your child will also take part in additional fluency sessions every day. This is where we develop children's fluency skills by recapping key skills in Maths.
