<u>English</u>

This term we will be looking at different genres of books, including narrative stories, reciting poetry and non fiction recounts, using the Talk 4 Writing approach.

We will be taking part in grammar lessons based on punctuation, suffixes and common exception words.

We will have a daily focus on Phonics in Year 2 where the children will learn sounds and take part in guided reading. We will also have weekly whole class comprehension sessions.

This term we will be looking at Multiplication and Division strategies, including fractions. As well as continuing to tell the time to 5 minute intervals, looking at angles and symmetry of shapes and revising addition and subtraction strategies.
